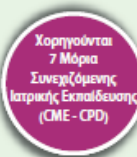

History of Carcinoid Tumors

1907: Oberndorfer coined the term “*Karzinoide*”

- Described tumorlets with these 5 features:
 1. Small size and multiple foci
 2. Undifferentiated cellular formations
 3. Well-defined borders
 4. No metastatic potential
 5. Slow-growing and harmless
