- Presenting authors of accepted abstracts will be notified in due time of the type, day and time of their presentation.
- Abstracts will be accepted under the condition that at least one author will be registered. **No presentations will be accepted without proof of congress registration**

ABSTRACT FORMAT

- The abstract should not exceed 250 words
- Abstracts must be typed in English using Times New Roman letter, 11pt size in single space.
- The title must be in capital bold letters and should not exceed 20 words.
- Include name(s) of author(s) in a new line putting initials first. Omit titles. The name of the Presenting Author should be underlined.
- The name of Institution(s) should be included in a separate new line.
- Clarity in presentation is requested. Objectives, methods, results and conclusions should be stated meaningfully and concisely.
- Authors are responsible for the content and quality of abstracts preparation and no editing will be done.
